



Feedlot Field Services Assistant

We are currently seeking a full-time or part-time Feedlot Field Services Assistant to join our animal health team. This position predominantly entails traveling to area feedlots to perform digital necropsies, deliver orders, and assist with research sample collection; however, tasks will vary seasonally. Helping unpack shipments, assemble orders, stock vet trucks, mow grass, plow snow, etc. are examples of daily tasks that may need completed each morning before setting out on field calls. If the successful applicant possesses an AHT or RVT designation, there is more opportunity to assist veterinarians and technicians with other clinical tasks in the field or animal health data management in the office.

Job requirements:

- An interest in beef production and a strong work ethic is required. An agricultural background and cattle handling experience are considered assets.
- Class 5 Driver's license
- Ability to lift/push up to 50lb.
- Willingness to work outside in all weather conditions
- Weekend availability

Salary and benefits:
